Transport

Transportation airport (Balice International Airport) – city – airport will be provided only to those who asked for it beforehand. Guests using the transfer provided by the organizer please search for a person holding an ASEM logo sign waiting at the arrivals.

It is also possible to travel to the centre by train (the train station is located 200 m from the T1 international terminal. To transfer between the terminals and the station use the free Shuttle Bus service, one-way ticket price bought from the train attendant: 8,00 PLN, one-way ticket price bought in automated cashiers: 7,00 PLN) or by bus (there are two regular bus lines: 208 and 292 and one night line: 902, price of a single ticket bought from the bus driver: 3.50 PLN). One can as well take taxi which should not cost more than 90 PLN one way.

Located 10 km south from Cracow the historic Salt Mine in Wieliczka is the only mining site in the world functioning continuously since the Middle Ages. Its original excavations (longitudinals, traverses, chambers, lakes, as well as minor and major shafts) are located on nine levels and extend for the total of about 300 kilometres: reaching the depth of 327 metres they illustrate all the stages

Matejko Square (tourist stop in front of the National Bank), return by buses from Wieliczka around 23.30 to the same place.


IMPORTANT: Due to low temperatures in the mine (during the sightseeing) please remember to take warm clothing (jacket, scarf, hat etc.)
